

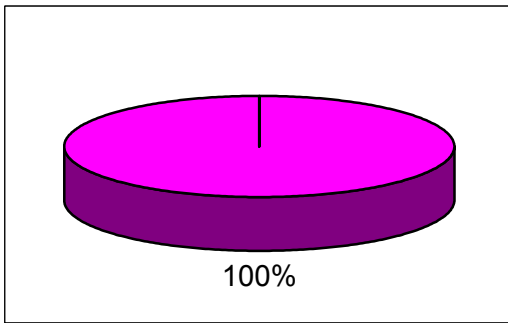

- All participants found the training sessions throughout the day to be very useful / useful.

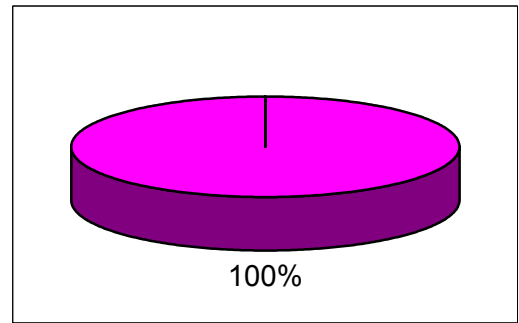

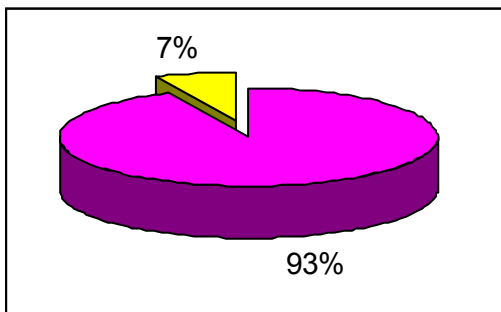
Session 1: Knowing Yourself and others, learning styles model and style features.



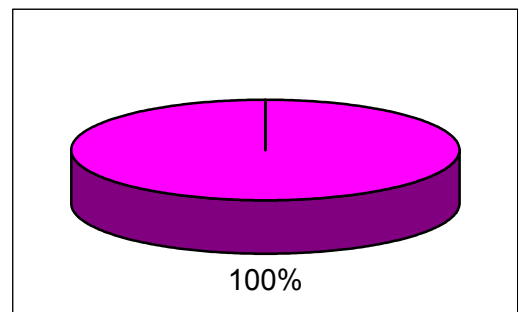
Session 2: Information intake (VATK) Learning style profile interpretations. Left / right brain dominance and its importance for school success
